

Nighttime Policies of the Information Center 24/7

- Users can visit the Information Center during its opening hours:

- Monday to Friday 9 pm – 9 am
- Saturday and Sunday 3 pm – 9 am

Users need to show and scan their Reader Cards at the entrance.

- Users are provided with 24 computer-equipped working places with access to the electronic catalogue, the TSU electronic library (repository), scientific and educational electronic resources, and also to the exhibition of the newest arrivals, and the collection of reference literature (general and subject oriented) and fiction (for entertainment and recreation).

- If one needs items from the main library collection for working during the nighttime operation of the library, one should request these items at the Circulation Desk beforehand and leave them in an individual locker at the Center. Keys to these lockers are provided by the Security staff after scanning one's Reader Card.

- After work with them, books should be left in a designated place (book return). Taking books out of the Information Center is prohibited.

- We remind you that there are no librarians in the Information Center from 9 pm to 7 am. If you have any questions, we suggest you address our virtual Information Desk: link on the site "Ask a librarian". You will get an answer to your question within 2 workdays.

- We urge you to adhere to the following rules:

- Laying on the couches is prohibited
- Being barefoot is prohibited
- Changing the computer settings at the Center, installing software, and using computers for playing videogames is prohibited
- Watching videos with sexual and extremist content is prohibited
- Eating is allowed only in designated places
