Universal Decimal Classification. How and where can it be found in the Research Library of Tomsk State University?

The Universal Decimal Classification (UDC) is an international system of information classification to codify various types of documents.

UDC index is applied to:

• editions (books, bulletins, monographs);

• published works (articles, report summaries) in accordance with editorial policies of academic journals and bulletins;

• graduation thesis.

To determine UDC index:

• contact TSU RL consultants of the Bibliographical information center or Reading Rooms;

• fill in an online form with the title of academic work, faculty (specialisation), contents list (contents of work), keywords, etc. and submit it to the Virtual reference service of the Library. Without these data, the service consultants will not be able to provide you with qualified service online.

To determine UDC index by your own you can use the online UDC reference book accessible from all Research Library computer-aided workspaces.
